

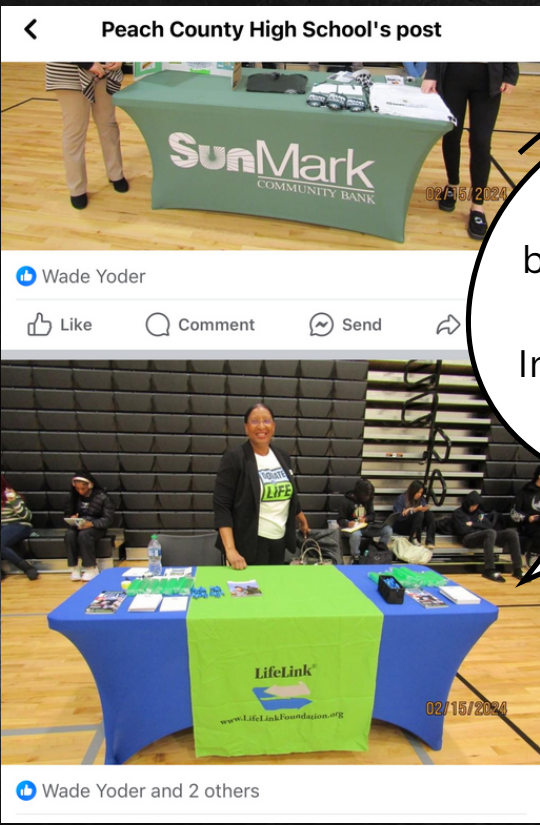

LifeLink and other businesses attend our yearly career fair to give students information on careers in our community.



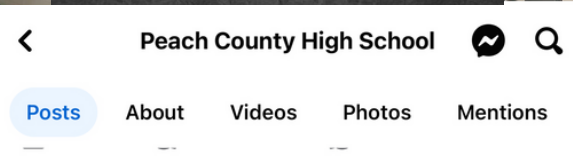

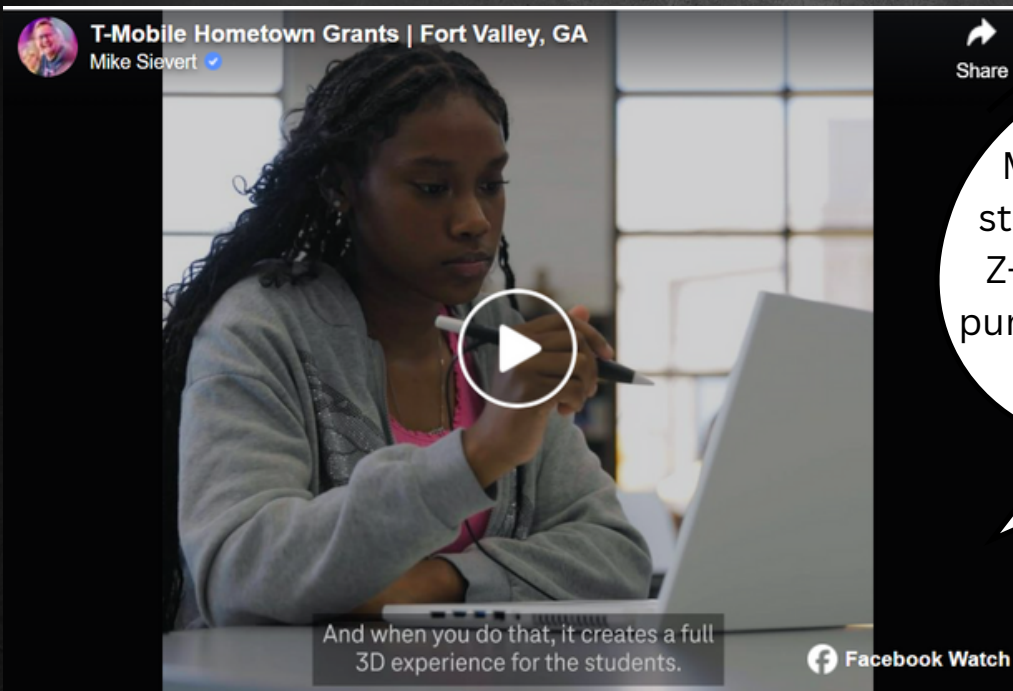
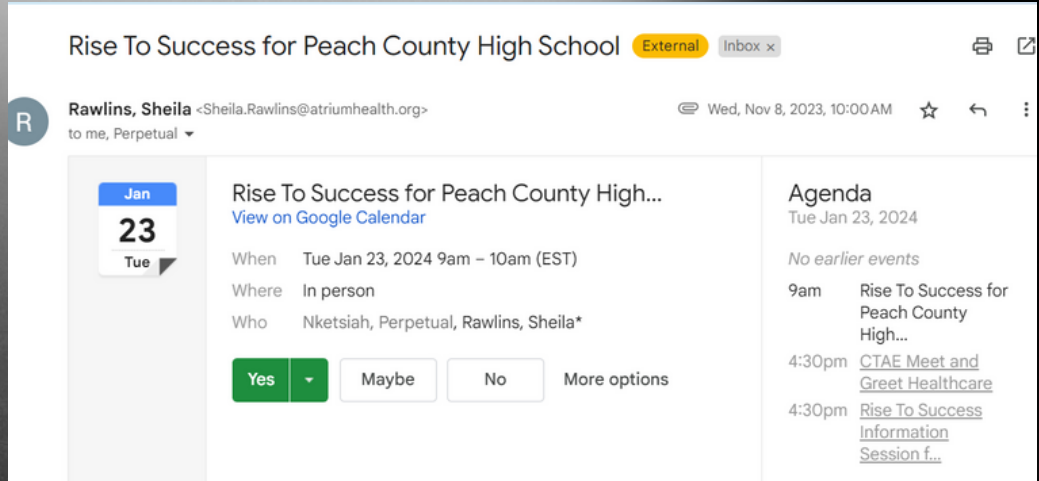
