The Peach County High School post-secondary committee is planning the College/Career Fair for the 9th-12th grade student body. We are hoping that you will choose to take part in this event. As you are aware, early exposure to colleges and universities, as well as career opportunities, will enable our students to be better prepared upon leaving high school and entering the world of post-secondary opportunities or the world of work.

The "Enroll, Enlist, Employ" Opportunity Fair will be held Thursday, February 15, in the Gymnasium at Peach County High School in Fort Valley, GA. The format will be: Careers/Businesses interacting with the students in the AM part of the day and Colleges, Universities and Military being showcased in the PM part of the day.

- **Careers/Businesses:** Arrive for set-up at 7:30 am. Students will tour in 25-minute intervals by grade level from 7:55-10:30 am. At 10:35 am, this group of visitors will prepare to depart the campus. Light hospitality will be provided.
- **Colleges/Universities & Military:** Arrive for set-up at 11:15 am. Students will tour in 30-minute intervals by grade level from 11:50 am- 1:30 pm. This group of visitors will prepare to depart the campus at 1:30 pm.

Upon your arrival at Peach County High School, please enter at the Moseley Road side of the campus and proceed towards the bus ramp area to park. The CTAE students will be available to direct you to the registration table and assist you with any materials. Table and chairs will be provided.

For **colleges and universities**, we ask that you orient the students toward your institution, to include entry requirements, majors, scholarship and work study opportunities, and most importantly, your personal insight into your institution and post-secondary options. You are welcome to bring promotional materials/items.

For our **business partners**, we ask that you orient the students toward your occupation, to include any entry-level requirements, advantages/disadvantages of particular jobs, and most importantly, your personal insight into your occupation. We also ask that you dress as you do daily for your job. You are welcome to bring promotional materials/items as well as information regarding possible positions for them.
