Grab a bowl of brisket chili and some sweets!

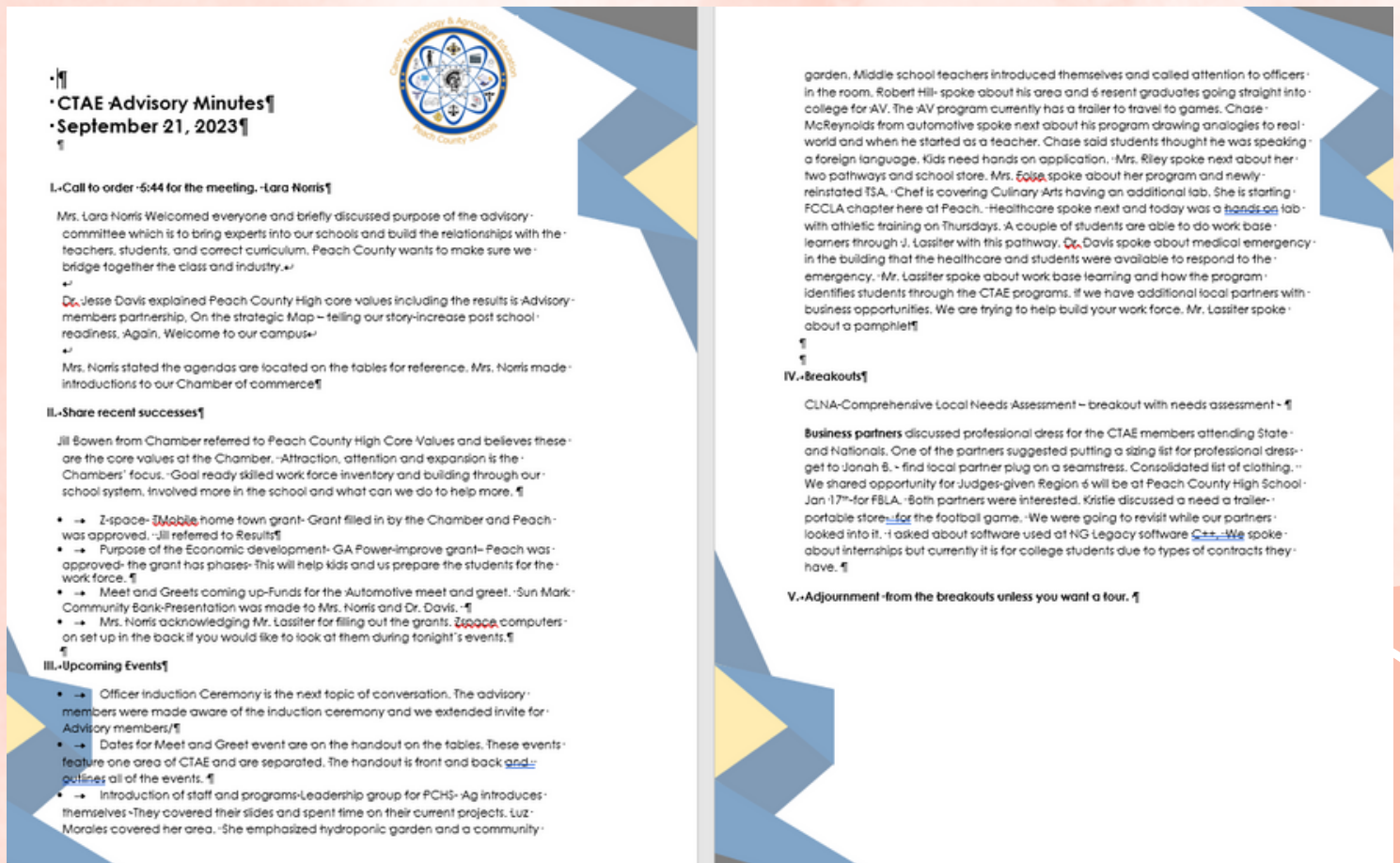
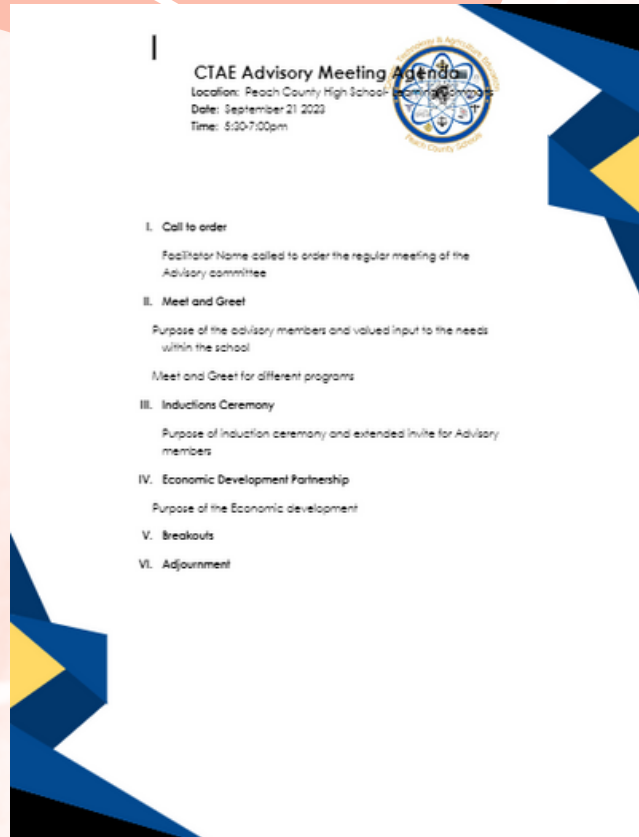

- Breaking News: Working with Jill Bowen of the Peach Regional Chamber of Commerce an application was submitted for the T-Mobile Hometown Grant of \$50,000. The Chamber has been notified that we have been selected for the grant. The money will be used to purchase 15 Z-Space AR/VR Computers.
- A review of the current pathways was completed along with a review of JobsEQ for Peach County as well as a regional review. This year's course student numbers were also provided. It was agreed that current pathway offerings matched the data showing high demand, high skilled workforce needs. Discussion was held on possible future pathway offerings. The recommendation was made for adding a teacher in Health Care Science, a Business Teacher, and Construction.
